

5.46 firms per thousand inhabitants are born in WMCA just short of the average of **5.88** for the country. The significant average growth rate over 2010-2015 point to convergence in the next few years and survival rates are improving.

Similar to the employment shares, the most important sectors in firm populations are manufacturing; wholesale and retail trade; transportation and storage; and human health.
